FINAL ORDER OF FORFEITURE

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2010, this Court entered a Preliminary Order of Forfeiture pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §§ 981(a)(1)(A) and 981(a)(1)(C) in conjunction with 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c), and entered a personal money judgment in the amount of \$3,522,880,614.00 against Defendant Robert Dean White;

WHEREAS, on January 6, 2011, this Court entered a Second Preliminary Order of Forfeiture pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 981(a)(1)(A) in conjunction with 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c) and 18 U.S.C. § 982(a)(1), and 21 U.S.C. § 853(p) forfeiting specific property listed in the Order to the United States;

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2011, this Court entered a Third Preliminary Order of Forfeiture pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 853(p) forfeiting specific property listed in the Order to the United States;

WHEREAS, the Plaintiff published Notice of the Second and Third Preliminary Order of Forfeiture for at least 30 consecutive days on an official government internet site (www.forfeiture.gov), beginning on January 24, 2011 and May 5, 2011, respectively;

WHEREAS, the United States served all known persons and entities with the Second and Third Preliminary Orders of Forfeiture;

WHEREAS, Robyn White filed an Amended Petition for Distribution of her Marital Interest in Proceeds as to the Zink Imaging, Inc. stock;

WHEREAS, this Court dismissed Robyn White's Petition;

WHEREAS, the 8th Circuit affirmed the District Court's dismissal of Robyn White's Petition; and

WHEREAS, no other petitions have been filed with the Clerk of Court and the time for filing a petition has expired;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. The Motion of the United States for a Final Order of Forfeiture (Doc. No. 79) is **GRANTED**;
2. all right, title and interest in the following property is hereby forfeited to and vested in the United States of America pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §§ 981(a)(1)(A) and 981(a)(1)(C) in conjunction with 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c), 18 U.S.C. § 982(a)(1) and 21 U.S.C. § 853(p):
 - a. A personal money judgment in the amount of \$3,522,880,614.00;
 - b. The remaining Balance of First Minnesota Bank Account No. 3157142 amounting to \$2,891.98 which was transferred into U.S. Bank account number

104778312918 by Receiver Kelley (the “White Receivership Account”) on or about November 19, 2008, as well as any appreciation and accrued interest;

c. The proceeds from the sale of White’s equity/stock interests in Zink Imaging amounting to \$3,000,000, which was transferred into the White Receivership Account in November 2008, as well as any appreciation and accrued interest;

d. The proceeds from the sale of White’s 2005 Porsche 911 Turbo Cabriolet VIN WPOCB29905S675377 amounting to \$50,187, which were deposited into White’s Receivership Account on or about May 6, 2009, as well as any appreciation and accrued interest;

e. The remaining balance of First Minnesota Bank Account No. 3909172 amounting to \$2,103, which was transferred to the White Receivership Account on or about November 19, 2008, as well as any appreciation and accrued interest;

f. The proceeds from the sale of the SV “Spirit” Hull, Kanter Yachts Benford Custom 65’ Yacht, with Hull ID No. ZKNCB646441787, Official Number 923999 amounting to \$315,000, which was transferred to the White Receivership Account on or about April 29, 2010 and May 5, 2010, as well as the refund of an insurance premium on this yacht in the amount of \$795, as well as any appreciation and accrued interest;

g. The State Farm Insurance Payout covering a totaled 2005 Honda Element with VIN 5J6YH27645L010676 and MN License Plate No. PHA 531 amounting to \$12,339.22 which was deposited into the White Receivership Account on or about April 13, 2010, as well as any appreciation and accrued interest;

h. 86,000 Shares of Medafor, Inc. Stock;

i. 120,000 Shares of International Motorsports Entertainment and Development Corporation; and

j. The net proceeds from the sale of the real property located at 538 Grace Street, Excelsior, MN; and

3. The above property shall be disposed of by the United States in accordance with law.

LET JUDGMENT BE ENTERED ACCORDINGLY.
